Staying Informed

Wednesday is Parent Day at Edison! The Edison PTA and classroom families take turns hosting an informal "Cafecito" each Wednesday at 8:15 am (linger a little for coffee/tea and conversation). Many parent meetings, Coffee with the Principal, or other workshops for parents are also held on Wednesday mornings. The "Wednesday Packets" are distributed weekly either in print or electronically (sign up to receive e-packets). The school newsletter, El Semanario, is distributed each Wednesday in the packets and published on the PTA website www.edisonamigos.com and the Edison website (www.edison.smmusd.org). The weekly PTA E-Blast with school and community information comes out each Sunday. Periodic announcements about important school events or emergency notices are sent via our district auto-dial system.
